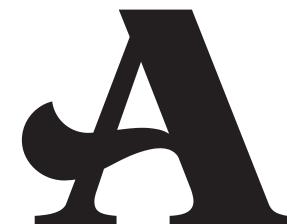

  - This is the Spring 2024 number that was invoices, will see a slight reduction after rosters are updated – Spring 2023 ended up with 1265
- 22-23 Initiations (490) down 4.5% from 21-22
- Fall 2023 Pledge Numbers: 343
  - Down 16% from Fall 22
- Fall 2023 Initiations: 294
  - 85.7% initiation rate
  - Down 12% from Fall 22



# Fall 2023 Financial Receivables Update

- 18 Chapters that had an outstanding balance from the Fall 2023
   Semester
- \$428,467.00 Invoiced
- \$359,510.44 received for Fall 2023 invoices
- \$68,956.56 outstanding for Fall 2023 invoicing
- 83.91% Collection Rate
- This does NOT include any past debt.
- Pre-Fall 2023 Debt
  - 12 Chapters
  - · ~\$220,000

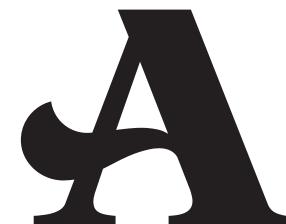
#### Scholarship Recruitment

#### **Chapter Standards Program Review**

- Only chapters participating in awards process were those who completed Chapter Standards program packet
- Fraternity not obtaining valuable data points from all chapters
- Discovered three different categories of data
  - Required
    - 1) it is stated as such in the Laws of Acacia
    - 2) for legal or insurance purposes
    - 3) the Oath you take during initiation says you will do it
  - Award Priority
    - Data <u>not required</u> but should be submitted if the chapter wants to apply for and receive awards.
  - If Sanctions/Conditions
    - Data points that fit in this category are <u>not typically required</u> but due to outlined sanctions or conditions, they become required for a specific chapter. Those who have these sanctions or conditions know about them.

#### **Process**

#### 1. Submit chapter reporting items

 These will give base for each award. Choosing to not submit them could mean lack of evidence/items needed to complete your award packet

### 2. Complete specific award forms for 11 different areas

- Submit via TypeForm
- Will include what we are specifically looking for based on Good-Better-Best document
- Explain why your chapter deserves this award
